After Treaty, the Leadership selection process will change from the Indian Act system to one that is adopted, as part of the NSTQ Constitution, by the NSTQ members. The Leadership will include Elder and Youth representation and will be elected by the NSTQ members. They will hold office for four years on staggered terms to ensure continuity.
