Seasonal Fisheries Technician Job Posting

Job Summary

The Seasonal Fisheries Technician is a motivated individual with a strong interest in natural resource management. They will contribute to the overall success of the Fisheries Program by performing various manual tasks including providing technical support in fisheries field surveys related to field operations and fisheries sampling throughout the Northern Secwēpemc te Qelmūcw.

Duties and Responsibilities

1. Provide technical support and assistance during assessments and enumeration activities;
2. Assists with implementing field surveys and sampling activities using a variety of gear types;
3. Participates / assists in the Catch monitoring program;
4. Conducts invasive species eradication and scientific technical sampling including, but not limited to:
 - a. fish habitat assessments, lake and stream water quality sampling; spawner enumerations;
 - b. Assist in collection, analysis, and recording of biological sampling and data
5. Maintains field logbooks (computerized and by hand) and abides by all Work and Safety Protocols;
6. Keeps equipment organized, maintained and inventoried, ensures sign out procedures are followed;
7. Assist in maintaining fisheries equipment including trucks and boats;
8. Other duties as assigned or required.

Education / Qualifications / Skills

1. Graduation from High School and Post-Secondary Education in Natural Resource field is an asset;
2. Ability to actively listen to ensure that you've understood direction and grasped new information;
3. Team environment: you genuinely enjoy engaging with the team to get work done;
4. First Aid Level 1 with transportation endorsement is an asset;
5. Must hold and maintain a valid BC Drivers license;

Working Conditions

1. Role will require travel in a variety of different work environments, at times outside normal business hours and must be comfortable and feel safe working in and around water;
2. Successful applicant will demonstrate the ability to: perform physical requirements of the job (walking, hiking, boating, heavy lifting) at times in extreme weather with the ability to work independently and / or as a team.
